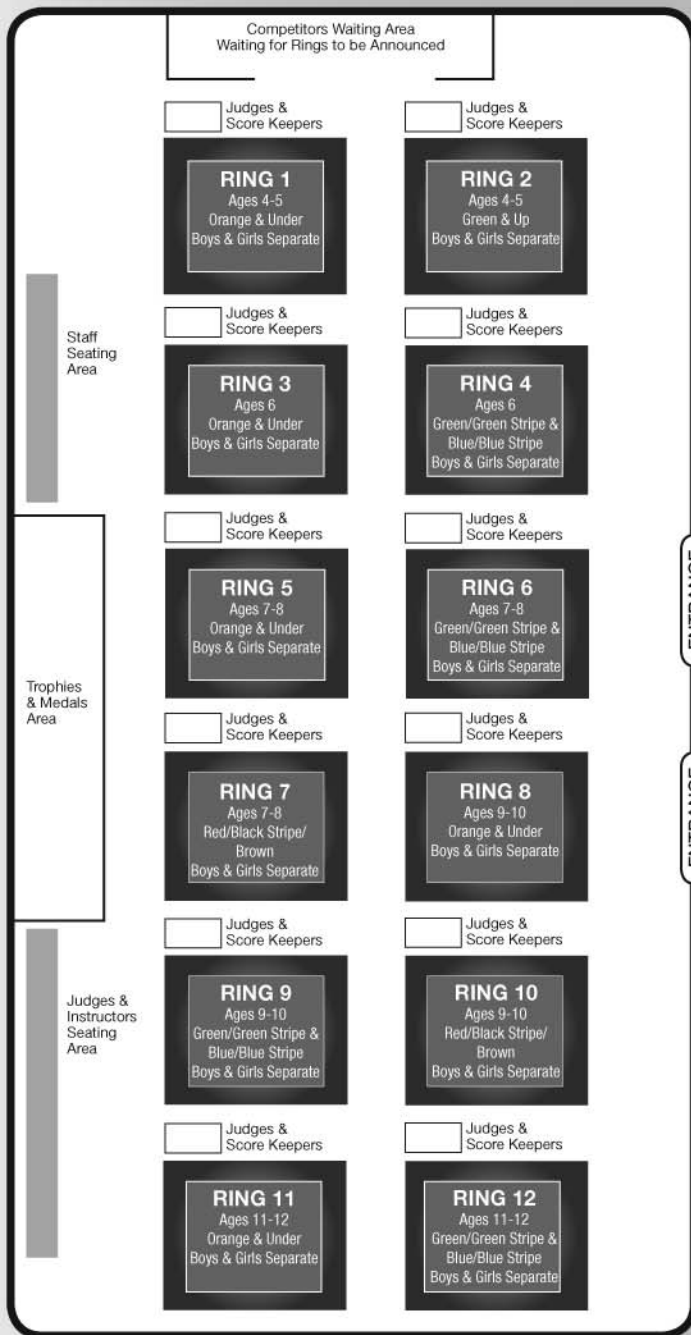

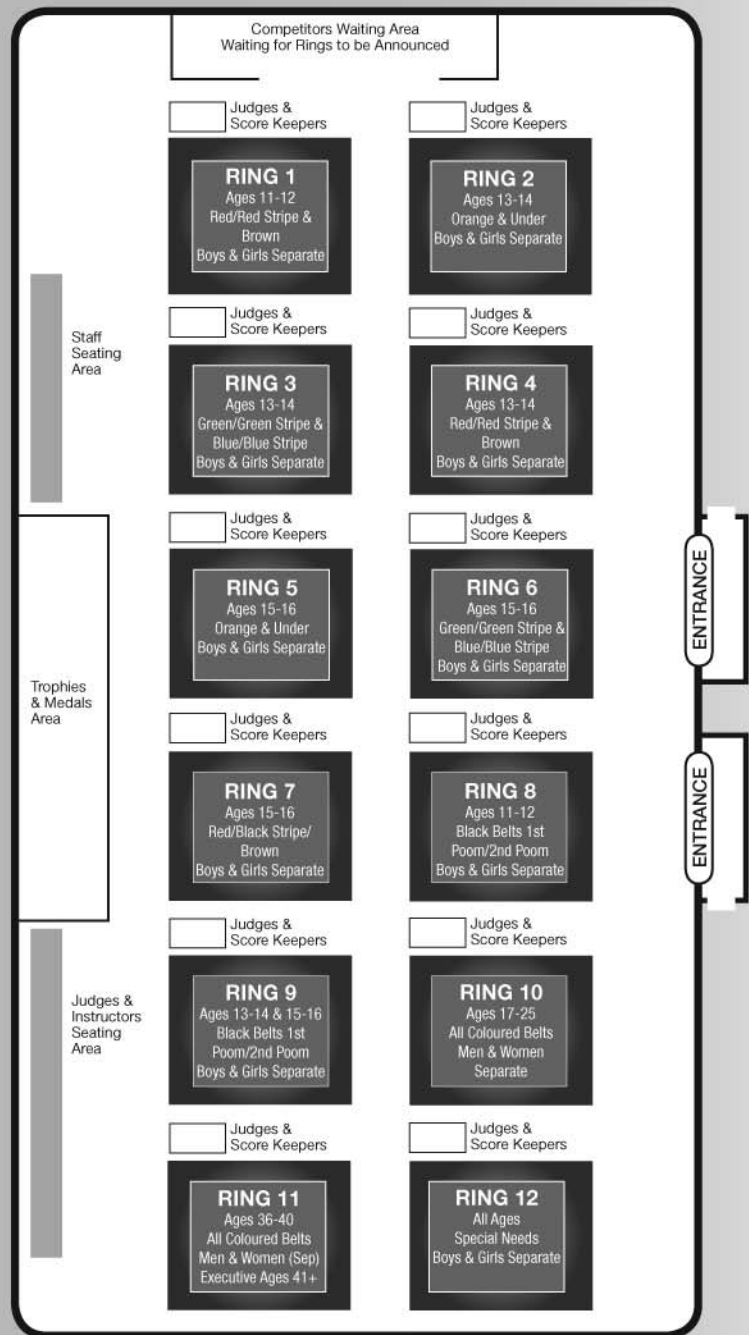

All competition in patterns & sparring will be competed on high density mat, approved by the World Taekwondo Federation to ensure the safety of all competitors. O.T.A. & W.T.F. rules shall be applied with no high section contact (head) for ages 13 years and under and control high section.

Competitors must bring the following mandatory, safety equipment

- 1• Head gear
- 2• Chest Guard (Hogoo)
- 3• Shin Guards
- 4• Groin Cups
- 5• Mouth Guards

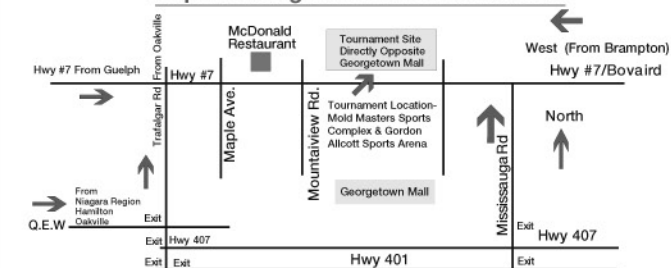
